for the Special Forces Regiment, the Civil Affairs Regiment, and the Psychological Operations Regiment
Active and Reserve

CRITERIA

1. Per current policy, nominee may be any active or retired officer, warrant officer, or enlisted member who has graduated the Special Forces, Civil Affairs, or Military Information Support Operations qualification course and is a member of their respective regiment. Individuals who are not members of a regiment but have made significant contributions are eligible for the award of "Honorary Member of the Regiment." Posthumous nominations are welcome.
2. Must have made significant contributions to their regimental success on the battlefield and/or to the training and qualification of new members to the regiment.
3. Upon retirement from the Army, must have made contributions to the regiment and/or the local community. Continued service to the regiment after separation from the military is particularly important to the program and can be through both formal and informal activities.
4. Nominations must include:
 - A letter of recommendation that includes point of contact information for the person being nominated (name, address, phone number, email address); if posthumously, contact information for next of kin.
 - Not more than a two-page, single-spaced bio on the nominee with assignments and accomplishments in chronological order of service, and awards earned. Include information on support provided to the regiment after retirement.
 - 8" X 10" head and shoulder (preferable) photo of good quality; original photos will be returned to the family. Photograph in uniform is also preferred.
